Forestry 4WD Adventure

- Hit the dirt road in Conondale National Park for some real four-wheel fun

- Get some mud on your tyres on Sunday Creek Road from Jimna to Charlie Mooreland Camping Area near Kenilworth
- Head north from Kilcoy along the Kilcoy-Murgon Road and turn off at Sunday Creek Road, 3km south of Jimna
- Kick up some mud as you follow the forest road through the national park
- For some bonus four-wheel drive action, take a side trip to Booloumba Creek
- Keep an eye out for Booloumba Creek Road and explore the Booloumba Creek walks and camping areas

Recharge, Refuel and Review Road Conditions

Fuel Stops: Fernvale, Lowood, Tarampa, Esk, Toogoolawah, Harlin, Kilcoy, Colinton and Somerset Dam.

Road Conditions: Be sure to check <u>qldtraffic.qld.gov.au</u> or <u>roadconditions.racq.com.au</u> for up-to-date information or road safety advice. Always drive to conditions and make safety a priority when on your travels.
